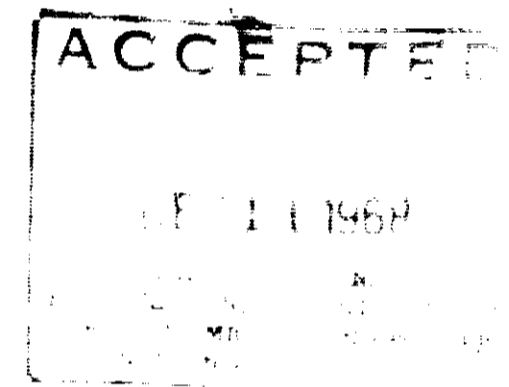


UTILITY



Frequently roots of trees and plants located near sewage and drainage lines, in their search for water, work their way through the joints of the piping. If not checked, they will continue to enter and grow inside the piping and eventually obstruct the flow of sewage and water, often causing complete blockage.

UTILITY Root Destroyer

A chemical in crystal form when dissolved in drainage water and absorbed by roots in piping will cause the roots to die up to the point of entry, drop off and be washed clear of the pipe.

Periodic use of Utility Root Destroyer will prevent accumulated growth of roots, avoiding stoppages with their expense and inconvenience.

NEW SOLUBLE PACKAGE

This box contains 4 sealed, water-soluble plastic bags, each containing 7 oz. of Utility Root Destroyer Crystals.

DIRECTIONS

Best results are obtained if all applications of Utility Root Destroyer are made at night when the smallest amount of water goes through drainage lines.

When applied at time and in amounts as directed, these soluble bags can be dropped unopened into a toilet or main trap. (Never into basin, sink or tub.) The bag dissolves in two minutes and the crystals can then be flushed into the drainage lines.

As a preventive. To ensure root-free drainage lines, apply a 7 oz. bag of Root Destroyer every three weeks during the spring and summer growing season. Follow this by the same treatment once every eight weeks during the remainder of the year.

Where root growth has reached the point where drainage is sluggish, 7 oz. applications should be made twice weekly until the condition has been corrected. Follow with preventive treatment as above.

Where root growth is so great as to cause complete blockage, quickest relief is obtained by having roots removed mechanically. To avoid future clogging use preventive treatment.
