

Venus 106 Bowl & Porcelain CLEANER

DIRECTIONS

TO CLEAN, DEODORIZE AND DISINFECT TOILET BOWLS.

Remove water from bowl by forcing it over the trap with a mop. Press water out of mop. Hold bottle over bowl and saturate mop with CLEANER. Clean entire bowl, especially under rim at water outlets. Flush bowl and rinse out mop.

MAINTENANCE CLEANING AND DEODORIZING:

Pour 4 or 5 ounces over inside of bowl. Let stand 3 or 4 minutes, flush toilet.

TO CLEAN, DEODORIZE, AND DISINFECT URINALS:

Hold bottle over urinal and saturate mop with CLEANER. Thoroughly wet and clean all surfaces, grooves and water outlets at top. Remove screen and pour 3 to 5 ounces around drain opening and into drain outlet to deodorize. Let stand 3 or 4 minutes. Swab drain thoroughly. Replace screen and flush well. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.

Keep Out of reach of children. May produce skin irritation, or on contact with eyes

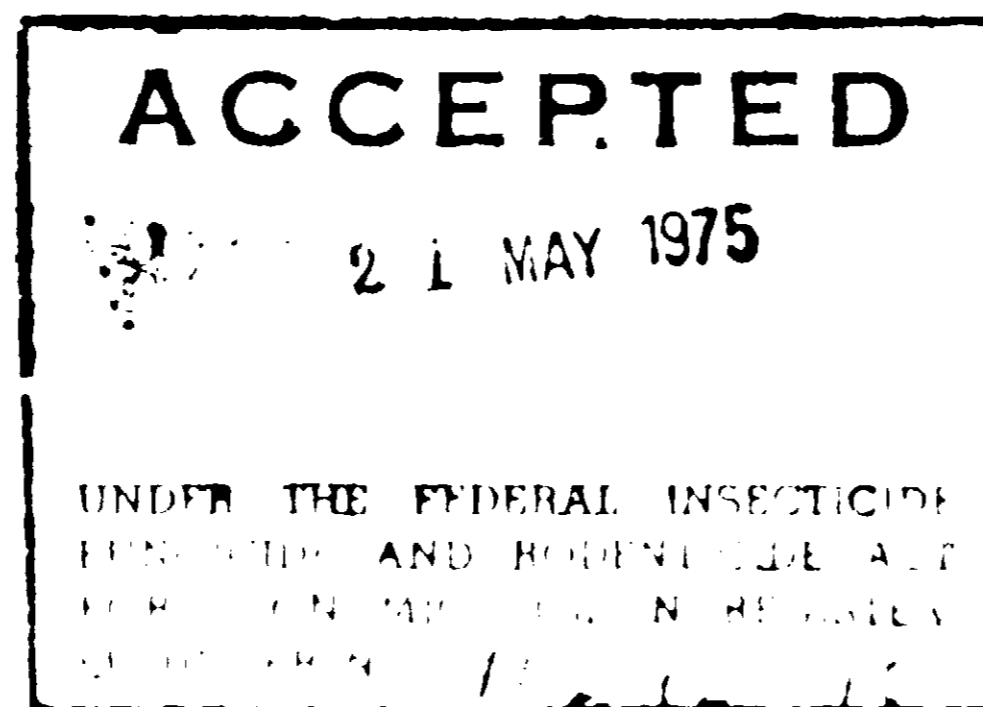
FIRST AID: If swallowed, drink plenty of water. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by a physician.

**TO REMOVE RUST AND HARD WATER STAINS
FROM PORCELAIN SINKS, BATHTUBS AND WASH
BASINS:** Apply with a soft cloth and rinse promptly
with cold water.

**TO REMOVE STAINS ON CERAMIC TILE FLOORS
AND TARNISH FROM BRASS:** Apply with cloth and
rinse with cold water.

**TO REMOVE METALLIC SOAP BUILD UP AND
STAINS FROM TILE FLOORS, WALLS, SHOWER
STALLS, DRINKING FOUNTAINS, SWIMMING
POOLS:** Apply with mop or cloth. Rinse thoroughly
and promptly with cold water.

NOTE: Do not use on MARBLE, TERRAZZO or
ALUMINUM. Do not allow bottle to stand on Porce-
lain while contents are being used.

DANGER - CORROSIVE

Keep Out of Reach of Children. May be fatal or
harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe vapor or fumes.
May produce chemical burns. Do not get in eyes, on
skin, or on clothing.

FIRST AID: If swallowed call a physician immedi-
ately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of milk of mag-
nesia or a cup of soapy water followed with milk or
raw egg whites.

Eye contact - Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get
prompt medical attention.

Skin contact - Wipe off the acid gently, immediately
flood the surface with water, using soap freely, then
cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.
