To Clean, Disinfect, and Deodorize Toilet

Bowls: Remove water by forcing over trap with bowl mop. Press excess water from mop, and holding bottle over the bowl, saturate the mop with this product. Clean entire bowl especially under the rim at water outlets. Flush bowl and rinse mop.

Maintenance Cleaning and Deodorizing:

Pour 4-5 oz. of this product over inside surface of bowl and allow to stand for 3-4 minutes then flush.

To Clean, Disinfect, and Deodorize Urinals:

Saturate mop as for toilet bowls, then thoroughly wet & clean all surfaces of the urinal, especially the grooves and water outlets at the top. Remove screen and pour 3-5 oz. into and around the drain opening. Allow to stand for 3-4 minutes, then replace screen.

To Remove Metallic Soap Build-up, Rust and Hard Water Stains: From porcelain, ceramic tile, shower stalls, drinking fountains, tile floors and walls, etc., apply with a soft cloth, and rinse promptly with clean water.

NOTE: DO NOT USE ON MARBLE, TERRAZZO, ALUMINUM OR MAGNESIUM. Do not allow bottle to stand on porcelain surfaces while using contents.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician immediately, then drink a teaspoon or more of milk of magnesia, or a cup of soapy water followed by milk or raw egg whites.

IN CASE OF EYE CONTACT: Flush eyes with clean water for at least 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention.

IN CASE OF SKIN CONTACT: Wipe acid off gently with a soft cloth, then immediately flood affected area with water, using soap freely. Cover with moistened magnesia or baking powder. If irritation persists, contact a physician.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container away from food and feed stuffs. Keep product in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: DO NOT REUSE CONTAINER. Triple Rinse container with water & place in trash Collector.
