This is in response to your amendment of revised labeling for the subject product.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions:

1. Change "First Aid" to "Statement of Practical Treatment (First Aid)".
2. Revise the ingestion statement to read: "If swallowed, promptly drink large amounts of water. Call a physician or poison control center immediately".
3. Include the following statement immediately below the Directions heading (which should be changed to "Directions For Use):" It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Submit one copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended label.

# BOWLEX

## BOWL SANITIZER

**TO CLEAN AND DEODORIZE TOILET BOWLS:** First flush out water, apply cleaner to swab or rag, and clean entire bowl thoroughly especially up under the rim. Flush toilet. To deodorize, pour 2-4 ozs. directly into the water remaining in the cleaned bowl. Swab entire bowl, seat, and cover with this solution. After deodorizing, rinse seat and bowl well.

**TO DISINFECT:** Pour 10 ozs. directly into water remaining in cleaned bowl. Swab entire seat bowl, and cover thoroughly with this solution. After disinfecting, rinse seat and bowl well.

**TO CLEAN AND DEODORIZE URINALS:** First flush, then clean urinal by wetting entire surface. Particular attention should be given to the grooves along the sides of water outlets at the bottom of urinal and pour 2-5 ozs. of cleaner in edge and into the drain trap. Allow to stand for 3-5 minutes. Then swab the inside pipe thoroughly. Replace screen and flush well.

**TO REMOVE RUST AND HARD WATER STAINS FROM PORCELAIN SINKS, BATHTUBS AND WASH BASINS:** Apply with a soft cloth and rinse promptly with cold water.

**TO REMOVE STAINS ON CERAMIC TILE FLOORS AND TARNISH FROM BRASS:** Apply with a soft cloth and rinse with cold water.

**DANGER: KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.** Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Avoid contact with clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors.

**FIRST AID:**  
 In case of skin contact, flush with water. If irritation persists, contact a physician immediately.  
 In case of eye contact, call a physician immediately.  
 If swallowed, promptly drink a glass of water or a gelatin solution, or if these are not available, contact a physician, Trauma Center, or Poison Control Center.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucous membrane irritation. Use of gastric lavage. Measures against depression and convulsions may be necessary.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**  
 Store at temperatures above 40 degrees Fahrenheit. Do not store with other chemicals.  
**DISPOSAL:**  
 Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse with water for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and destroy by incineration, or, if allowed by state or local authority, burn in a controlled incinerator until burned slay out of smoke.
