Dear Mr. Marrese:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the conditions listed below.

- Update First Aid Statements

Conditions

1. Delete the language referring to this product as "Pink Spice". Such language changes regarding the formulation must be accompanied an alternate formulation which contains an ingredient in agreement with "Pink Spice."
2. Revise the Directions for Use by correcting to read: "Clean the *urinal*, then place the Uni Tab in the fixture, with the..."

3. As per PR Notice 83-3, revise the Storage and Disposal Instructions to read as follows:

“STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage *or* disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Keep container closed *and stored in an area to make inaccessible to those unfamiliar with its use.*

Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap *chemical block* in several layers of paper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. *Wrap container and put in trash.*”

4. As per the Label Review Manual, 3rd Edition, revise the Precautionary Language as follows: *“WARNING: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles, protective clothing and gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.”*

The language which you have proposed in this section is not adequate.

5. Revise your “First Aid” statements to be in agreement with PR Notice 2001-1 to read as follows and be in the following order:

“If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing...

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse...then continue rinsing eye. *Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.*” Delete the statement beginning: “If irritation persists...for treatment advice.”

You may retain the **“If Swallowed”** statement.

Add the following statement to the end of this section: *“Have product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.”*

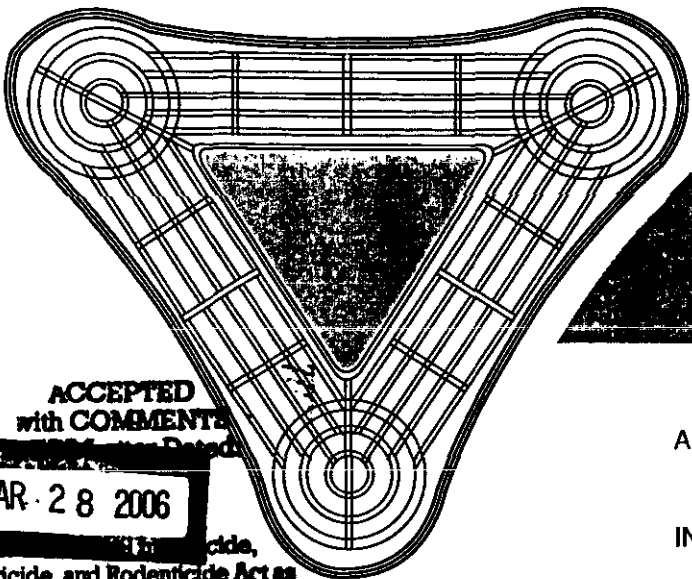
