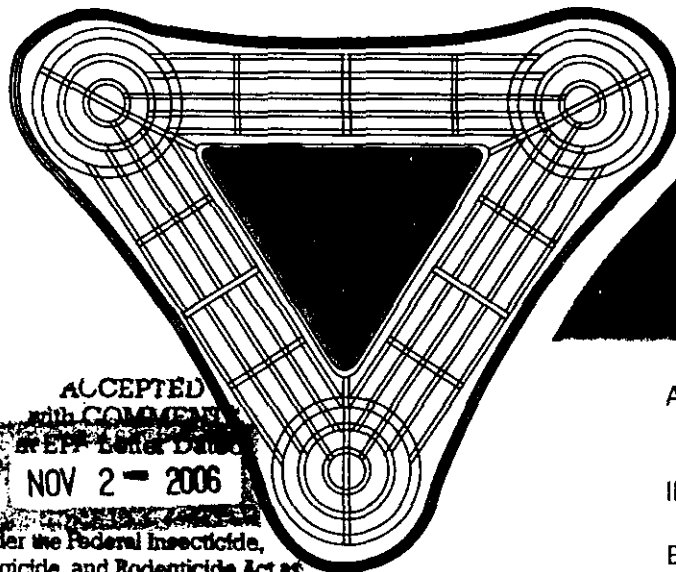

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Clean the urinal, then place the UNI•TAB® in the fixture, with the exposed face of the chemical block face down. UNI•TAB® should not be placed so that it is completely submerged in water as this will drastically cut down on its effective life. Replace when the chemical block is depleted.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
