Sweep up and destroy insects up and destroy insects.

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CONTACT SPRAYS: To kill roaches, ants, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes: Adjust spray to produce large wetting type spray particles. Direct spray to contact these insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets, and other harborages. Spray these infested areas until thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing, all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray doors, window frames, trails and hills.

TO KILL GRAIN INSECTS: Adults of confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles: Remove infested

sawtoothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles: Remove infested grain cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in the areas by removing before spraying.
