LAUNDERING: washing machines, automatic washers, etc. Bleach cleans and sanitizes fast colors, white linens and sheet, also nylon, rayon and cotton, or any mixture of these fabrics with cotton or linen. WILL NOT HARM SEPTIC TANK OR MACHINE.	1 oz. or 1/8 cup of bleach to each 2 gallons of water, or 1/4 cup per washing machine load. 1/8 gallon for lightly soiled clothes use proportionately less Bleach.	Use Bleach in the usual manner. Do not use Bleach in the same water as you use for washing clothes.
TO WHITEN YELLOWED OR GRAYED NYLON, RAYON OR COTTON.	Use 2 tablespoons 1/8 cup bleach to one gallon fairly warm water.	Soak in solution 15 to 20 minutes. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary.
REMOVE SCORCH & STAINS such as fruit, ink, berry, wine, coffee, tea, chocolate, grease, etc. Also mildew.	One part Bleach to 10 parts water, or 1/4 cup Bleach per quart of water.	Soak for 15 to 30 minutes. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary.
CLEANING KITCHEN & BATHROOM Bleach is excellent for cleaning tile, porcelain, enamel-ware, bathtubs & linoleum.	2 tablespoons 1/8 cup Bleach per quart of cold water.	Scrub with toothbrush. Rinse well. Do not stand in mixture. Repeat if necessary.
FOR EMERGENCY DRINKING WATER.	Use 10 drops of Bleach to each gallon of water.	Let stand 5 to 10 minutes. Taste.
SPECIAL DISINFECTING USE: Dishcloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, baby clothes, etc.	3 tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of cold or lukewarm water.	Fast wash in clear water. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary.
REFRIGERATORS.	3 tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of warm water.	Thoroughly wash inside of refrigerator. Keep wet for 24 hours. Rinse well with plain water. Air dry.
SICK ROOM: URINALS, REPTANS, SPUTUM CUPS, ETC.	3 tablespoons of Bleach per quart of hot water.	Wash clean. Place in drainage. Do not flush. Repeat if necessary.
SWIMMING POOLS: Bleach may be used to make pool water hygienically cleaner and safer for health.	Use 28 oz. (3 1/2 cups) of Bleach to each 10,000 gallons of new water.	Thoroughly mix bleach in 20 pails of water. Feed solution through a strainer and scatter over surface of pool. Repeat frequently and add Bleach as needed. (10 A.M. to 10 P.M. when water is clear. Bleach will not harm fish.)
TOILET BOWLS, DRAIN PIPES, to deodorize.	Full strength. For stains, 1/2 cup of toilet bowl and a few drops of vinegar or lemon will remove stains.	Apply full strength solution. Do not mix with other cleaning agents. Rinse with plain water.

LAUNDERING. For washing machines, automatic washers or tubs. Bleach bleaches and sanitizes fast colors. For white cottons and linens, also nylon, dacron and orlon, or any mixture of these fabrics with cotton or linen. (WILL NOT HARM SEPTIC TANK OR MACHINE.)	1 oz. or 1/8 cup of Bleach to each 2 gal. of water, or 1 cup per washing machine load (16 gallons). For lightly soiled clothes use proportionately less Bleach.	Add Bleach to soap or detergent. For use in machine, do not mix with other chemicals. Add 1 quart of water before use.
TO WHITEN YELLOWED OR GRAYED NYLON, DACRON OR ORLON	Use 2 tablespoons 1/8 cup Bleach to one gallon fairly warm water.	Immerse in solution for 20 minutes to 1 hour. Soak in warm water. Repeat if needed.
REMOVE SCORCH & STAINS such as fruit, ink, berry, wine, coffee, tea, chocolate, grease, etc. Also mildew.	One part Bleach to 20 parts water, or 1/4 cup Bleach per quart of water.	Soak for 5 to 10 minutes in Bleach solution. Rinse well.
CLEANING KITCHEN & BATHROOM. Bleach is excellent for cleaning tile, porcelain, enamel-ware, bathtubs & linoleum.	2 tablespoons 1/8 cup Bleach in quart of cold water.	Spread with cloth moistened with solution. Let stand 2 minutes. Rinse well.
FOR EMERGENCY DRINKING WATER	Use 10 drops of Bleach to each gallon of water.	Let stand 5 to 10 minutes before drinking.
SPECIAL DISINFECTING USES. Dishcloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, baby clothes, etc.	3 tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of cold or lukewarm water.	First wash in clear water. Immerse in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse well.
REFRIGERATORS	3 tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of warm water.	Thoroughly wash inside, outside and top. Keep wet 5 minutes with Bleach solution. Rinse well with plain water. Air dry.
SICK ROOM, URINALS, BEDPANS, SPUTUM CUPS, ETC.	3 tablespoons of Bleach per quart of hot water.	Wash clean. Place in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse. Dry.
SWIMMING POOLS. Bleach may be used to make pool water hygienically cleaner and safer for health.	Use 28 oz. (3 1/2 cups) of Bleach to each 10,000 gallons of new water.	Thoroughly mix bleach in 20 parts of water and feed solution through a chlorinator. Stir and scatter over surface of pool. Repeat frequently and add bleach as needed. Maintain 0.6 to 1.0 P.P.M. level. Chlorine bleach will not harm plastic.
TOILET BOWLS, DRAIN PIPES to Deodorize	Full strength. For stains: 1/2 cup in toilet bowl and a few drops of vinegar or lemon will remove stains.	Wash with plain water. If necessary, scrub with wire brush. Rinse with plain water.
