

DIRECTIONS

Algae, in the absence of proper controls, may develop rapidly in swimming pools, especially during warm weather. Eagle Algicide is effective against growth of algae and aids in maintaining pool water clarity.

Eagle Algicide is compatible with all chemicals normally used in swimming pool maintenance, however, in its concentrated form, this algicide should not come in contact with high concentrations of chlorine. Do not mix Eagle Algicide and chlorine together when adding to the pool. All chemicals should be handled separately.

Eagle Algicide may be stored for prolonged periods of time without losing its effectiveness or strength.

Algae Treatment

Eagle Algicide should be added by pouring directly into pool. The pool's recirculation system will assure rapid dispersion.

Initial Application (original filling or when pool water is changed): Add 1/2 gallon of Eagle Algicide for each 15,000 gallons of pool water.

Continuing Application or Treatment: Add one pint (2 cups) every three to five days per 15,000 gallons of pool water to prevent further growth. In clear or cloudy weather, a pint should be added every week.

Winter Application: Add one pint per 15,000 gallons of water after a heavy or prolonged rainfall or when the bathing load is heavy.

The above directions should be followed even when pool is not in use.

Abolish Foot Fungus:

To control trichophyton interdigitalis (Athlete's Foot), thoroughly wet walking areas around pool with a solution of two ounces of Eagle Algicide per gallon of water.

Disinfecting and Decolorizing

Eagle Algicide may be used for disinfecting and decolorizing floors, walls, toilet fixtures, garbage pails, etc. Heavy deposits of soil or other matter should be removed by washing or flushing with water prior to application of the disinfecting solution. After the surfaces have been pre-cleaned, apply a solution of one ounce of Eagle Algicide per gallon of water in a manner so as to wet thoroughly the surfaces being treated. Do not mix disinfecting solution with soap or detergent.

How to Figure Pool Capacity

Rectangular pools- length times width times average depth (in feet) times 7.5 equals gallons

Round and oval pools- average diameter times average diameter times average depth (in feet) times 5.9 equals gallons.
