HAZARDS TO HUMANS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while holding eyes open. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water immediately. After drying apply Vitamin E cream or oil (these can be purchased at most pharmacies, drug stores and supermarkets). If Vitamin E cream or oil is not immediately available apply any vegetable oil liberally over any painful areas. The oil or cream (vegetable or Vitamin E) may be used repeatedly until relief is achieved. Symptoms will often disappear over several hours and, with Vitamin E oil or cream, sometimes comes within minutes. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and provide oxygen if breathing is difficult. Get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Do not give liquids if victim is unconscious or very drowsy. Otherwise, give no more than 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by giving 30cc (2 tablespoons) syrup of Ipecac*. If Ipecac is unavailable, give 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of victim's throat. Keep victim's head below hips while vomiting. Get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: *If victim is a child, give no more than 1 glass of water and 15 cc (1 tablespoon) syrup of Ipecac. If symptoms such as loss of gag reflex, convulsions or unconsciousness occur before emesis, gastric lavage should be considered following intubation with a cuffed endotracheal tube.
