CAUTION

1. **STORAGE**

FIRST AID

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE OF THIS PRODUCT

Wear long-sleeved shirt and pants, shoes and socks, and use chemically-resistant gloves when mixing or applying product. Do not use in food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other establishments/areas where food is commercially prepared, processed, or served. Sumi-alpha® 10MC is designed for use only as a residual and crack and crevice spray to control various pests in and around homes, and non-food areas of schools, warehouses, office buildings, apartment buildings, theaters, hotels, motels, kennels, food processing plants, truck trailers, railroad cars, and food service and warehousing establishments. Use only in areas described. Do not use this product in a fogger or as a space spray. Product may be sprayed on any surface which will not be damaged or stained by water. Do not mix this product with other end-use products. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums and pets' food and water dishes before spraying. Keep all people (especially children) and pets out of the areas being treated, and restrict access to these areas until all surfaces are dry. Do not leave product where children or pets can come in contact with it. Do not allow spray to contact food or food-containing surfaces, feed or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they are contaminated with this product. Utensils such as teaspoons and measuring cups must not be used for food purposes if used with pesticides.

DILUTION (Dilute ONLY with water): Shake container before diluting. Clean spray equipment before and after use. To dilute, add water to spray tank with appropriate amount of Sumi-alpha® 10MC. Agitate sprayer before using and occasionally during use to ensure uniformly diluted product. Application of the 0.06% dilution is suitable for control of heavy infestations and gives at least six weeks of residual control of German cockroaches on cement. Application of 0.3% solution is suitable for control of light infestations and gives at least one week of residual control for German cockroaches. Apply in two second bursts of spray per foot of area being treated. Avoid excess application. Dampen surfaces, but do not saturate or soak.

To make 0.03% AI solution:	1 volume	to	320 volume (parts)
To make 0.06% AI solution:	1 volume	to	160 volume (parts)

If reinfestation occurs after application of the 0.03% mix, do not retreat or apply this product more frequently than once a week.

Sumi-alpha® 10MC controls: ants, box elder bugs, carpet beetles, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, dog ticks, earwigs, millipedes, fleas, pill bugs, scorpions, silverfish, spiders, sowbugs, and wasp & hornet nests.
