PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe the spray mist and avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not enter or allow others to enter treated area until sprays have dried. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.

Shake Well Before Use - Hold container upright and apply in short bursts. Wait to see if insects are knocked down before re-spraying. Sweep up fallen insects. Always spray away from yourself and avoid spraying at other people or pets. Do not treat more than every 3 days.

FOR INDOOR USE:

In homes, apartments, basements, attics, garages, kitchens, bathrooms, and other household areas.

To kill flying insects at rest: Before spraying, cover or remove exposed food and utensils. Aim nozzle and spray directly on as many of these pests as possible.

To kill crawling insects: Aim nozzle and spray directly on as many of these pests as possible. Also spray into cracks and crevices and other hidden areas where these pests may hide; such as under sinks, stoves and refrigerators, around plumbing service and other inaccessible areas. When possible directly spray pests, such as when they are driven out of their hiding places. Repeat as needed.

ANTS: Apply to ant trails; also around doors, windows and wherever ants enter house.

FOR OUTDOOR USE:

Not for use in automated applicator systems such as misters. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply within 25 ft of lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other bodies of water. All outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, picnic areas, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications. Do not apply directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Before spraying, cover or remove exposed food and utensils. To Kill flying insects at rest: Aim nozzle and spray directly on as many of these pests as possible.

Product is not intended to kill wasp, hornet or yellow jacket nests. To kill crawling insects: Spray exterior surfaces of building(s), tree trunks, patios and other surfaces where these insects are seen. Aim nozzle and spray directly on as many pests as possible. Spray into cracks and crevices and other hidden areas where these pests may hide. When possible directly spray pests, such as when they are driven out of their hiding places. There is no need to overspray. Spray infested surfaces of patio or picnic area, hitting as many pests as possible. Spray ant hills and trails if ants are seen (but this product is not intended to kill ant nests).
