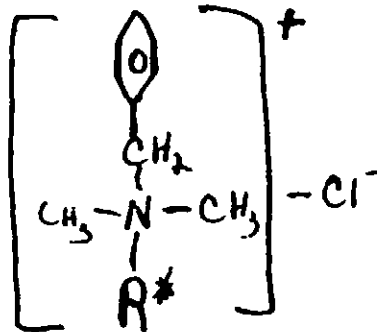

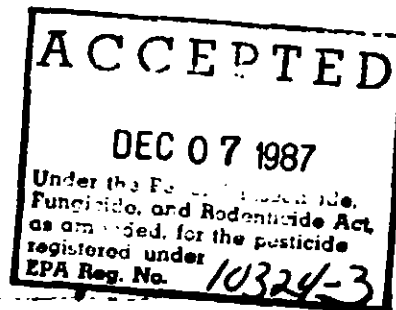

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open burning is prohibited.

Do not reuse empty container.

2. STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Store in original container. Keep from freezing.

3. SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES

Small spills may be mopped up and flushed away with water or absorbed in some absorbent material and incinerated. Large spills should be contained, the material then moved into containers and disposed of by approved methods for hazardous wastes.

4. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL
