



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
DANGER
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS
KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. CORROSIVE

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

3. SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES
