

# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

## DANGER

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. CORROSIVE

Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush the eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed drink PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probably, mucosal damage may, contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or other waters unless in accordance with a NPDES permit. For guidance contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS — Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.
2. STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS — Store in original container. Keep from freezing.
3. SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES — Small spills may be mopped up, flushed away with water or absorbed on some absorbent material and incinerated. Large spills should be contained, the material then moved into containers and disposed of by approved methods for hazardous wastes.
4. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL — Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by the use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
5. CONTAINER DISPOSAL — Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling (if accepted), or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and authorities.
6. GENERAL — Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approval of alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
