DANGER

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS
KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. CORROSIVE**

Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush the eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed drink PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin, soft stool, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Probably, mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS — Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.
2. STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS — Store in original container. Keep from freezing.
3. SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES — Small spills may be mopped up, flushed away with water or absorbed on some absorbent material and incinerated. Large spills should be contained, the material then moved into containers and disposed of by approved methods for hazardous wastes.
4. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL — Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. The correct alkyl chain length distribution for the active ingredient should be:

51% (C₁₂), 47% (C₁₃), 2% (C₁₄)
Disodium Benzyl Sulfonate Chloride Sulfonate

- 2. Also delete the parentheses after C₁₂.
