1. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

- a. Delete the word: Concentrated.
- b. Add the words: Federal Law, to the misuse statement
- c. Revise the front panel descriptor to read:

For use by manufacturers only in formulating sanitizers, disinfectants and water treatment microbiocides

d. Revise "... flush the eyes with plenty of water..." to read:

"...flush eyes or skin with plenty of water..."

2. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

3. The submitted Confidential Statement of Formula (dated June 11, 1993) is acceptable. Note also that this confidential will supersede all previous confidentials.

**STORAGE AND

1. PROHIBITIONS

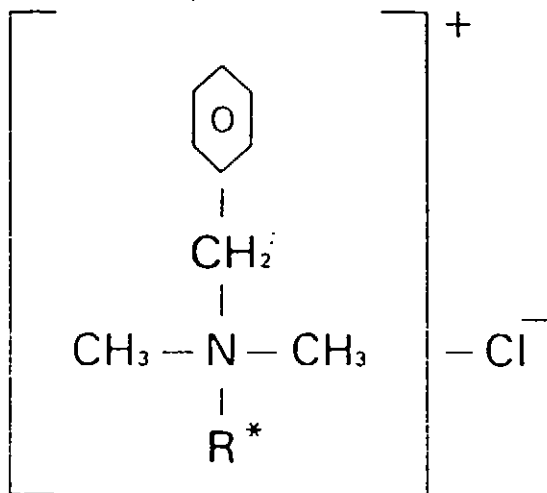
5. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

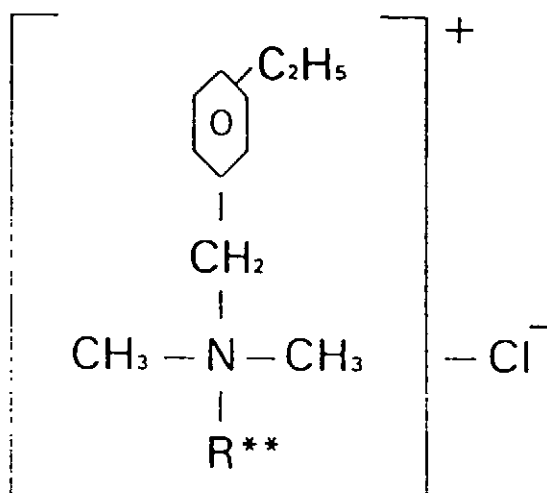
