

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
DANGER
 HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. CORROSIVE
 Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contact with food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
 In case of contact, immediately flush the eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician in medical emergency.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN
 Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against or curatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

1. PROHIBITIONS

 CONSULT FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL DISPOSAL AUTHORITIES FOR APPROVED ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURES SUCH AS LIMITED OPEN BURNING.
