



**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
DANGER**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS
KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. CORROSIVE**

Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Acid contains small amount of

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush affected area with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink

PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk or egg whites. Do not induce vomiting. If these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Also contact a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

For eye and skin damage, flush with water. For ingestion, induce vomiting. Measures against respiratory depression and shock may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Toxic to fish and other aquatic life. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or other water bodies. Use only in accordance with label directions. Do not mix with other pesticides.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Corrosive to metals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

Do not mix with other chemicals. Do not use in food preparation areas.

2. STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Store in original container. Keep from freezing.

3. SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES

Small spills may be mopped up, flushed away with water or absorbed on some absorbent material and incinerated. Large spills should be contained, then laterally then moved into containers and disposed of by approved methods for hazardous wastes.

4. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or container may violate Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by the user according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

5. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Do not reuse or refill this container. Do not burn or incinerate. Do not pour into water.

6. GENERAL

Keep out of reach of children. Do not use if container is damaged, leaking, or empty.
