#### Dear Velma:

In accordance with 40CFR152.44(c), we are submitting two labels with identical minor label changes under one application.

Per your letter dated 6/22/07, we have changed the HVAC claim on our labels to read "HVAC&R system". In addition, we have removed the treated article claim for wallboards and plastics. We will address those sites at another time.

Please note that both MUP's use the same chemicals - however, one is 50% active and one is 80% active.

In addition, in accordance with FIFRA 122(a)(1)(B) since "collateral labeling" documents are not "referred to on the label" and do not "accompany the product", we do not believe such documents are required for this review.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### First Aid
