GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

Add one ounce per gallon of water. Use Maquat-80 for sanitizing and cleaning of equipment and utensils in food processing, dairy industry, bars, restaurants, institutional kitchens and farms. No rinse is required.

For heavily soiled equipment or utensils, pre-wash with a good detergent. Rinse with clean water. Then apply recommended dilution of Maquat-80 with a cloth, mechanical spray device (spray surface until thoroughly wetted) or immersion. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 1 minute. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use-solution becomes visibly dirty. Do not re-use mechanically applied use-solution for sanitizing.
