
Dear Mr. Mason:

- Delete the "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children" statement from the precautionary 2. statements.



3. Delete the organism "Klebsiella pneumoniae" from the label since no efficacy data exist on file to support the claim.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
