SWIMMING POOLS

INITIAL DOSE: Add 5 1/4 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Add 1 1/4 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

If a visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. If visible algae are still present, repeat procedure as necessary. When pool is clear, add maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added weekly. In case of unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose.

If make up water is added at the rate of more than 1/2 fluid ounce MAQUAT 4450-P for each

When swimming season is over, add maintenance dose. This helps provide a measure of control of algae. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool during the season.

When MAQUAT 4450-P is used as directed against Chlorococcoides (green algae), Phaeocystis (blue-green algae), and Pleodorina (other swimming pool algae and slime producing organisms).

Versicolor

For persistent algae or slime producing organisms, add MAQUAT 4450-P into the skimmer with the pump off and allow the system to run for 24 hours. Turn off the filter pump and add 1/2 ounce of MAQUAT 4450-P continuously for 24-48 hours, brushing the pool walls.
