Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."
- Revise the Container Disposal statement to read: "CONTAINER DISPOSAL(Larger than 1 gal.) - Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then 2. offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or, if allowed by state and local authorities by burning. If burned, stay out

- 3. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae.
- 4. If algae is still visible repeat dose (steps 3 & 4) as necessary until pool is free of visible algae.
- 5. Once algae is under control, clean filter and return to normal operation.
