DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To remove visible yellow or mustard algae, (All dosages are for 10,000 gallons of water.)

1. Brush walls and floor areas affected by yellow algae accumulations.
2. Apply 4 oz (4 capfuls) of this product per 10,000 gallons as close to the affected areas as possible. For severe accumulations, double the above dosage.
3. Superchlorinate by adding 1 gallon liquid chlorine or 1 lb. of a dry chlorine per 10,000 gallon.

Swimming may be resumed a few hours after treatment.

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE OF TREATMENT:

To prevent accumulation of yellow algae: (All dosages are for 10,000 gallons of water)

1. With water temperature over 80 degrees, add 4 oz (4 capfuls) of this product with 1 gallon liquid chlorine or 1 lb. of a dry chlorine once a week.
2. With water temperature under 80 degrees, add 2 oz (2 capfuls) of this product weekly and 1/2 gallon liquid chlorine or 1/2 lb. of a dry chlorine.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
