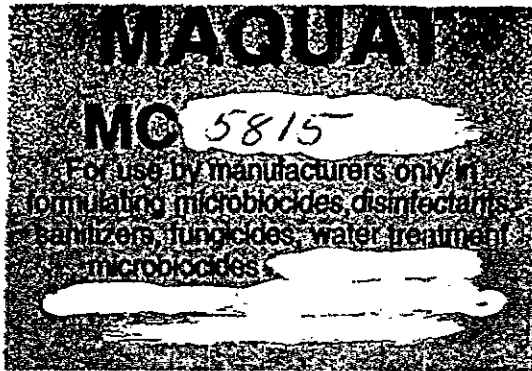

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

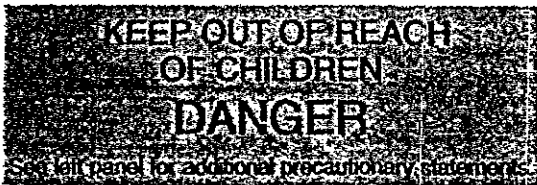

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
