The product chemistry data submitted to satisfy registration requirements is acceptable, with the understanding that the final results of the one-year storage stability study and corrosion characteristics study will be submitted when completed.
- 4. On page three make the following revision in the left column: add the following statement to the directions for "Preparation of Use Solution": "Mix 4 ounce packet per gallon of water."
- 5. On page five, revise the section "Commercial Floral Use Directions" as follows:
- A. Add the statement "Allow to air dry." immediately following revise the statement "Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes."
- B. Revise to state "Prepare a fresh solution at least daily or sooner if use solution becomes visible dirty."
- 6. On page five, revise the directions for "Disinfection of Whirlpool Units" as follows:
- A. Change the heading of this section to read "Disinfection of hard non-porous surfaces in Whirlpool Units"
- B. Revise such that the statement "Wash down the unit sides...with a clean swab, brush or sponge." is immediately followed by the statement "Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes." This statement does not need to be repeated at the end of this section.
- 7. On page six delete the entire left panel subtitled "Water Damage Restoration" and "Special Instructions for Cleaning/Sanitizing Carpet Against Odor Causing Bacteria." Your citation of Reg. No. 61178-1 does not support this use since the cited product does not contain the same active ingredients as your product.
- 8. You may retain the instructions on the right panel of page six but please be advised that when the Agency proposed 40 CFR Part 152/156 guidelines are finalized you will no longer be allowed to use the term "sanitizer" when referring to non-public health organisms.
 - 9. On page seven make the following revisions:
- A. Revise "Mix each section with 1 gallon of water" to read "Mix each packet with 1 gallon of water".
- B. Revise each panel of the label to include the statement "Mix each packet with 1 gallon of water".

WATER DAMAGE RESTORATION

SANITIZER AGAINST ODOR-CAUSING BACTERIA AND HIM HOME, INSTITUTIONAL, INDUSTRIAL AND HOSPITAL USE

This product is particularly suitable for use in water damage restoration situations to sanitize against odor causing bacteria on the following porous and semi-porous materials: carpets, carpet cushion, subfloors, drywall, trim and frame lumber, tackless strip and paneling. Using solutions recommended, saturate affected materials with enough product to remain wet for at least 10 minutes. Use proper ventilation.

Sewer Backup & River Flooding: During mitigation procedures, dilute 8-16 ounces of the product per gallon of water allowing for the diluting effect of absorbed water within saturated materials. Remove gross filth or heavy soil along with non-salvageable materials. Saturate all affected areas with a sprayer using a course spray tip, before and after cleaning and extraction.

Carpets, Carpet Cushions and Other Porous Materials such as Subfloors, Drywall, Trim and Frame Lumber, Tackless Strip and Paneling: For water damage from a clean water source, extract excess water. Test hidden area for colorfastness. Dilute 8-16 ounces of the product per gallon of water, allowing for the diluting effect of absorbed water within saturated materials. Remove gross filth or heavy soil. Apply directly with a sprayer using a course spray tip, to fully saturate affected materials. Roll, brush or agitate into the materials and allow the materials to remain damp for 10 minutes. Follow with a thorough extraction. Dry rapidly and thoroughly.

Special Instructions for Cleaning/Sanitizing Carpet Against Odor Causing Bacteria:

The product may be used in industrial and institutional areas such as homes, motels, hotels, chains, nursing homes, schools and hospitals. For use on wet-cleanable synthetic fibers. Do not use on wool. Vacuum carpet thoroughly prior to cleaning/sanitizing. Test fabric for color fastness. For portable extraction units: Mix 4 ounce of the product per gallon of water. For truck mounted extraction machines: Mix 96 ounces of the product per gallon of water and meter at 4 gallons per hour. For rotary floor machines: Mix 8 ounces of the product per gallon of water and apply at the rate of 300-500 sq. ft. per gallon. Do not mix this product with other cleaning products. Follow the cleaning procedures specified by the manufacturer of the cleaning equipment. After using the product, set the carpet pile and protect the carpet from furniture legs and bases while drying. Do not over-wet. If applied to stain resistant nylon carpet, apply a fabric protector according to the carpet manufacturer's directions.

CARPET SANI ... ZER AĞAINST ODOR-CAUSING BACTERIA, FOR HOME, INSTITUTIONAL, INDUSTRIAL AND HOSPITAL USE

This product sanitizes the carpet by controlling/reducing the growth of odor-causing bacteria. It can be used in industrial and institutional areas such as homes, motels, hotel chains, nursing homes and hospitals.

Vacuum carpet thoroughly prior to application. Mix 4 ounce of product per gallon of water. Follow the Injection and/or Extraction procedures as specified for any conventional steam cleaning equipment you are using. For rotary floor machines, mix 8 ounces per gallon of water and spray on carpet at a rate of 300-500 sq. ft. per gallon.

For use on washable synthetic fibers. Do not use on wool. Test color fastness of carpet before use. Apply diluted product to a small concealed spot, then rub with a clean white cloth. If color changes or transfers to cloth, a water-based product should not be used.

After using the product, set carpet pile in one direction with a stiff brush. Place aluminum foil under the legs of furniture while carpet is drying. Over-wetting can cause carpet to shrink. Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for over-wetting misuse.

NOTE: This product should not be mixed with other cleaning products.

Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, for the pesticide, registered under EPA Reg. No. 10324-114 an hourly or every other hour basis. If this is done, fog for 30-90 ands once per hour or once every two hours. Thoroughly scrub all treat feed facks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent, and rinse with potable water before reuse.

FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS USING FOGGING DEVICES

Prior to fogging, food products and packaging material must be removed from the room or carefully protected. After cleaning, fog desired areas using one quart per 1000 cu. Ft of room area with a solution containing 5.7 ounces of product to 1 gallon (1200 ppm). Vacate the area of all personnel for a minimum of 2 hours after fogging. All food contact surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed prior to reuse with potable water.

NOTE: The fog generated is irritating to the eyes, skin and mucous membranes. Under no circumstances should a room or building be entered by anyone within two hours of the actual fogging. If the building must be entered, then the individuals entering the building must wear a self-contained respirator approved by NIOSH/MSHA, goggles, long sleeves and long pants.

FOGGING IS TO BE USED AS AN ADJUNCT TO ACCEPTABLE MANUAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING OF ROOM AND MACHINE SURFACES.

VETERINARY PRACTICE/ANIMAL CARE ANIMAL LABORATORY/ZOOS/PET SHOP/KENNELS DISINFECTION DIRECTIONS: For cleaning and disinfecting the following hard non-porous surfaces: equipment not used for animal food or water, utensils, instruments, cages, kennels, stables, catteries, etc. Remove all animals feeds from premises, animal transportation vehicles, crates, etc. Remove all litter, droppings and manure from floors. Walls and surfaces occupied or transversed by animals. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Saturate surfaces with a use solutions of 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN per gallon of water (or equivalent dilution) for a period of 10 minutes. Ventilate buildings and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed set or dried.

FARM PREMISE USE:

Do not use in milking stalls, milking parlors or milk houses. Remove all animals and feed from premises, vehicles and enclosures. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes and other facilities and fixtures occupied or transversed by animals. Empty all throughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Saturate all surfaces with a use solution of 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN per gallon of water (or equivalent dilution) for a period of 10 minutes. Immerse all halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used in removing litter and manure. Ventilate buildings, cars, trucks, boats and other closed spaces. Do not house livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, managers, throughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent and rinse with potable water before reuse.

ULTRASONIC BATH DISINFECTANT DIRECTIONS:

Use MAQUAT 32 MN to disinfectant hard non-porous noncritical objects compatible with Ultrasonic cleaning units.

Pour fresh solution at 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN per gallon of water (1:32) directly into bath chamber. Preclean heavily soiled objects. Place objects into unit and operate for a minimum of 10 minutes, according to the manufactures directions.

Remove objects and wash with sterile water (sterile water for injection) or allow to air dry. Prepare fresh solution for each use.

COMMERCIAL FLORIST USE DIRECTIONS: To clean, disinfect and deodorize hard non-porous surfaces in one step, prepare use solution by adding (mixing) 4 ounces per gallon of water (1:32). For heavy-duty use Maquat 32 MN as is.

Remove all leaves, petals, garbage and refuse. Pre-clean surfaces using pressurized water where possible. Apply use solution to hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces thoroughly wetting surfaces as recommended and required, with a cloth, mop, brush, sponge or sprayer.

For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required.

For sprayer applications, use a coarse mist pump or trigger sprayer. Spray 6-8 inches from surface; rub with brush, sponge or cloth. Do not breathe spray mist.

Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes.

Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

DISINFECTION OF WHIRLPOOL UNITS: After using the whirlpool unit, drain and refill with fresh water to just cover the intake valve.

Add 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN for each gallon of fresh water added. Start the pump to circulate the solution. Wash down the unit sides, seat of the chair, lift and any/all related equipment with a clean swab, brush or sponge.

After the unit has been thoroughly cleaned, drain the solution from the unit and rinse any/all cleaned surfaces with fresh water.

Repeat for heavy soiled units.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Clean-up should always be one wearing protective latex gloves, gowns, masks and eye protection.

CLEANING PROCEDURE: Blood and other body fluids containing HIV-1 must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of MAQUAT 32 MN.

CONTACT TIME: Leave surface wet for 10 minutes with 4 ounces per gallon (32) milliliters per liter) use solution.

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS: Blood, body fluids, cleaning materials and clothing should be autoclaved and disposed of according to local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

Non-Acid Toilet Bowl Disinfection/Cleaner Directions:

POULTRY (AND SWINE) PREMISE SANITATION

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SITE PREPARATION

The first step in any on-going sanitation program shedild be the removal of gross contamination and debris. This may be accomplished under the peancide. No. 114 vacuum depending on the area to be disinfected. The efficacy of even the most efficient germicidal cleaner is reduced in the presence of heavy organic matter. Once the heavy debris is eliminated thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water.

CLEANING AND DISINFECTION

For all general cleaning and disinfection use 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN per gallon of water. Apply MAQUAT 32 MN using a cloth, mop, or pressure sprayer so as to thoroughly wet surface to be disinfected. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry. For heavily sollod areas, a precleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution after each use, J

Remove all animals and feeds from premises, trucks, cars, coops and crates. Remove all litter, droppings and manure from floors, wails and surfaces of facilities

occupied or trainised an inimals. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding end watering applia. s. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Use 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN per gallon of water. Saturate surfaces with the recommended disinfecting solution for a period of 10 minutes. Ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub treated feed racks, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent, and rinse with potable water before reuse. Immerse all halters, ropes, and other types of equipment used In handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers used for removing litter and manure.

HATCHERIES: Use 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN per gallon of water to treat the following hard non-porous surfaces: hatchers, setters, trays, racks, carts, sexing tables, delivery trucks and other hard surfaces. Leave all treated surfaces exposed to disinfectant solution wet for 10 minutes or more. Rinse with potable water before reuse. Then allow to air dry.

VEHICLES: Clean all vehicles including mats, crates, cabs, and wheels with high pressure water and MAQUAT 32 MN. Use 4 ounces per gallon to treat all vehicles. Leave all treated surfaces exposed to disinfectant solution wet for 10 minutes or

SHOE BATH SANITIZER: Shoe baths containing one inch of freshly made solution should be placed at all entrances to buildings, hatcheries and at all the entrances to the production and packaging rooms. Scrape waterproof shoes and place in a 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN per gallon (32 milliliters per liter) of water solution for 60 seconds prior to entering area. Change the disinfectant solution in the bath daily or sooner if solution appears dirty.

DRESSING PLANT USE: Disinfect equipment, utensils, walls and floors in poultry and animal dressing plants. Disinfect offal rooms, exterior walls and loading platforms of dressing plants. Cover or remove all food and packaging materials. Remove all gross soils. Saturate all surfaces with the recommended use solution, 4 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN per gallon of water. Scrub to loosen all soils. Allow to soak for 10 minutes and thoroughly rinse all wetted and cleaned surfaces with potable water.

SANITIZING HATCHERY ROOMS USING FOGGING DEVICES

Remove all animals and feed from premises, vehicles and enclosures. Remove all litter and manure from floors walls and surfaces of the room to be treated. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Close room off so fog is confined to room to be treated. Mix eight parts MAQUAT 32 MN to five parts water (4 gallons MAQUAT 32 MN to 2.5 gallons water). Insert the nozzle of the fogger through a suitable opening into the room. With the setting in maximum output, fog for one minute for each 4000 cubic feet of space in the room. When fogging is completed ventilate buildings and other closed spaces. Do not house livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed or dried. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water.

SANITIZING INCUBATORS AND HATCHERS USING FOGGING DEVICES

Mix 48 ounces of MAQUAT 32 MN to 122 ounces of water. Fog 3-8 ounces of this into setters and hatchers immediately after transfer. Repeat daily in setters and every 12 hours in hatchers. Discontinue hatcher treatments at least 24 hours prior to pulling the hatch. Do not allow people to contact or breath this fog and do not enter until the fog has settled (30-60 minutes after fogging is completed). DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

(This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or, (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to preclean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection)

PREPARATION OF USE SOLUTION:

For water hardness up to 400 ppm add 4 ounces per gallon (32 millillters per liter) of water (1:32) to disinfect hard non-porous surfaces.

MAQUAT 32 MN is a Hospital Use Disinfectant at 4 ounces per gallon (32 milliliters per liter), (1:32 dilution), modified in the presence of 400 ppm hard water.

MAQUAT 32 MN is Bactericidal according to the AOAC Use Dilution Test method. Virucidal* according to the virucidal qualification on hard inanimate surfaces, modified in the presence of 5% organic serum against:
