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- B. Revise the section headed "Storage & Handling" to include the following: "Use in well ventilated area. Do not get in eyes, nose, or on skin. Gloves, protective clothing, safety goggles or face shield and respirator must be worn when..."
- 5. Submit revised Certification With Respect to Citation of Data Forms. The submitted forms do not correctly identify the general use patterns for this product. Revise to state "Indoor and Outdoor."
- 6. Upon completion, submit storage stability and corrosion characteristics studies to the Agency for review.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label and technical bulletin is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label and each Certification With Respect to Citation of Data Form prior to the release of the product for shipment.
