This is an amended letter to the letter dated January 15, 2009

- Revised the label per letter dated January 15, 2009.

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

- 1.) Revise the Environmental Hazards section on page 1 to be in agreement with the DDAC and ADBAC REDs by adding the following statement, "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates."
- 2.) The nomenclature for Influenza A is incomplete on pages 2 and 6. You need to indicate that the microorganisms are viruses by stating "Influenza A Virus."
- 3.) Revise the 10<sup>th</sup> claim in right column on page 3 by indicating "hard nonporous surfaces of cervical collars and neck braces."
- 4.) Revise the "For Disinfecting Hard, Non-Porous Surfaces Against Avian Influenza A" heading on page 7 and 11 by citing the organism's complete nomenclature, Avian Influenza A "Virus."
- 5.) Revise the second to last statement under "Food Processing Plants Using Fogging Devices" on page 8 to read "Vacate the area of all personal for a minimum of 2 hours after fogging and a minimum of 4 air exchanges (ACH) per hour in the facility."
- 6.) Revise the "Meat Packing Plants" directions on page 11 by deleting the statement, "For application saturate all surfaces with solution and scrub to loosen all soils," and replacing it with the statement, "Pre-clean all surfaces prior to use to remove gross soils."


