LAWN FUNCE: For contributions, or at first sign of disease. Helminthasporium, Rhizoctonia brown patch, Curvuloria Fading-out, and I in Blight, apply Consum Triple Action 20 at a rate of one tablespoon per guilon of weiter. Treat at rate of one guilon to 40 squille feet (4 ft. x 10 ft.) of lawn, if entire lawn is not treated, apply solution at least one fort bayond infected areas to prevent spreading of infection. Repeat Applications are to be made at 10 to 14 day intervals as nected with New or Established cases. Treatment is required during werm weather, and may be made when grains is dry or day to during wet rainy weather.

GOLF COLINGES AND COMMERCIAL TURF GROWERS: Follow instructions for favor fungi, if commercial power sprays are uslied, reduce the solution ratio to one teaspoon per gallon of water.

ROSES: Use 1-1/2 teaspoons per gallon of water to control leaf black sput and powdery mildow. Apply at first signs of disease by any convenient means but be sure to wat all plant surfaces. Apply in warm weather. Repeat in 10 to 14 days, and thereafter as inserted, De not apply during vist, rainy weather.

PEAR TREES AND CREPE NYRTLE: Use a solution of one tablespeen per guillar of water to control Sactarial Freblight. Sirey, mist or rings the complete plant, Treat pear trees only in early Spring and after hervest in late fall while still dermant. Crepe Nyrtle should be treated during warm weather, and after pruning. Treatment should be repeated at two weak intervals as need at.

GREENHOUSE — HARD SURFACES: To disminot hard instrumes surfaces (such as glass, work surfaces, barches, flats, pots, tools, coaler pads, well-ways, and wells) add 1/4 oz. Consur Trule Action 20 to one gallen of water. Apply solution with mop, clott, spongs, or mechanical soreyer so as to wet thoroughly. Allow to remain wet to ten minutes, and then let air dry.


