

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For control of anaerobic bacteria in oil field waterflood, saltwater disposal systems, crude oil and gas storage systems, and other oil field water process systems. Add 50 to 100 ppm VISCO 3993 (5-10 gallons per 2400 barrels of water) continuously until the desired degree of control is achieved. Follow up with 5-50 ppm VISCO 3993 (.5-5 gallons per 2400 barrels of water) continuous feed to maintain control.

VISCO 3993 may also be fed intermittently at a rate of 25-100 ppm (1-10 gallons per 2400 barrels of water) for 4-16 hours a day, one to seven times a week or as needed to maintain control.
