**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions.

For control of anaerobic bacteria in waterflood, saltwater disposal system, water process systems. Add 35-200 ppm (5-20 gallons per 2400 barrels of water) until the desired degree of control is achieved. Follow up with 25-100 ppm (2.5-10 gallons per 2400 barrels of water) to maintain control.

ROBAN 3999 may also be fed intermittently at a rate of 35-200 ppm (1-20 gallons per 2400 barrels of water) for 8-20 hours a day, once a week or as needed to maintain control.

ROBAN 3999 may be added at any point in the water stream. ROBAN 3999 is water soluble and will not interfere with oil dewatering or coagulation.

Feed ROBAN 3999 directly from the discharge point. Do not use any type chemical pump.
