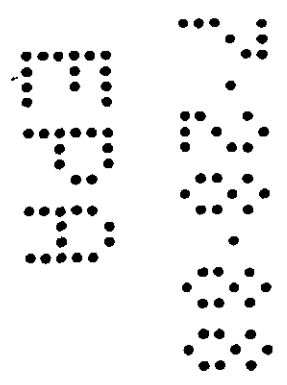


**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

1. PROHIBITIONS - Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL - Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. **DIRECTION FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its's labeling.

**DRILLING FLUIDS**

DRYOCIDE is a highly effective microbiocide for use in controlling growth of fungi and bacteria found in water based drilling muds. It is especially useful in muds containing starches, Xanthanate gums and wood sugars. The uncontrolled growth of these fungi and bacteria can cause increased corrosion, undesirable odors and degradation of the drilling mud, especially fluid loss properties.

DRYOCIDE is used at the rate of 3 to 15 pounds per 100 bbl. of mud (60-300 ppm). It can be used directly from the shipping container or pre-dissolved in water. It can be put in through the mud hopper or added to the pump suction.

**FRACTURING FLUIDS**

For the control of bacteria in fracturing fluids. add 0.3 to 1.6 pounds DRYOCIDE per 1000 gallons of fracturing fluids (33-160 ppm).
