The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

1. Delete the substatement to the ingredients statement "Contains Petroleum Distillate", as the actual amount of petroleum derivative in this product is such that this claim is not necessary.
2. Correct the spelling of the word "Insecticide", which appears on the front panel of the product label in the sentence which begins "Ready-to-use microencapsulated....".
3. Expand the precautionary statement which begins "May be used in food areas, but..." to read as follows: In food areas, food should be covered or removed prior to treatment. All food contact surfaces and utensils should be covered or removed prior to treatment, or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

Directions for Use: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Sectrol Insecticide may be applied as a **GENERAL SURFACE SPRAY**.

Before use, shake thoroughly and adjust sprayer to deliver a coarse spray.

On Cats and Dogs - works up to 8 days. For best results, shampoo pet with product recommended by veterinarian. Towel dry. Hold sprayer a few inches from pet. Start by spraying pet's head (avoiding contact with the eyes) and work your way back to the hind quarters. Spray under the furcoat by back-combing against the direction of hair growth with your other hand. It is important to wet the entire furcoat and any exposed skin thoroughly to assure adequate coverage. Allow pet to dry or use blow dryer. Do not freeze dry as this will remove many of the microcapsules. Reapply weekly or as needed.

On Household Surfaces - works up to 30 days. Thoroughly vacuum all carpeting, upholstered furniture, along baseboards, under furniture and in closets. Seal vacuum bag and dispose. Mop hard floors. Replace pet bedding. Using a smooth back and both motion, spray all floors and other abovementioned areas thoroughly, especially pet resting areas and other areas your pet frequents. Repeat application after 30 days or as needed.

Refrain from vacuuming treated areas until flea cycle is broken (normally 10-14 days). If you vacuum, retreat vacuumed areas.

This bottle treats 115 square feet. If product begins to run off or leave pools, you are spraying too heavily. Sectrol Pet and Household Flea Spray will not damage surfaces that are unaffected by water.

To Treat Other Household Pests: (including ants, beetles, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, fleas, flies, gnats, moths, silverfish, spiders, ticks, waterbugs, and weevils) direct this spray to areas where these pests are found, such as: baseboards, storage areas, closets, around water pipes, doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, stoves, and other similar areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.
