

## SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING!

Directions for Use: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. For best results, bathe the pet with an insecticidal shampoo recommended by your veterinarian.
2. Rub off excess water with a towel. Your pet does not have to be thoroughly dried.
3. Adjust nozzle on bottle of SECTROL Two-Way Pet Spray to deliver a coarse spray. Hold sprayer within a few inches of the haircoat. Apply SECTROL Two-Way Pet Spray so that your pet is moist - not soaked. When applying to cats do not exceed 10 grams (10 squeezes of the trigger sprayer) for each pound your cat weighs.
4. Start by spraying your pet's head (avoiding contact with the eyes) and work your way back to the hind quarters. Spray under the haircoat by backcombing against the direction of hair growth with your other hand.
5. Rough up the hair as needed to expose skin to insecticide. It is important to apply SECTROL Two-Way Pet Spray as evenly as possible over your pet's body because fleas will migrate to untreated areas (e.g., toes, foot pads, around the ears, etc.).
6. Applying this product at the level described in #3 above will provide rapid flea kill and at least 8 days residual activity. Because some animals, particularly cats and kittens, may be sensitive to insecticides, do not exceed the recommended application rate on cats and kittens unless so advised by your veterinarian.
7. Allow your pet to dry. Do not towel dry as this will remove many of the SECTROL Two-Way Pet Spray microcapsules. (These micro-capsules provide the insecticide's timed-release residual activity.) A blow dryer works well to shorten the drying time.
8. For best control, reapply weekly.
