c. Revise your Environmental Hazards paragraph to read:

This pesticide is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority in writing. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

d. In your storage and disposal directions delete "Open burning is prohibited." Revise the Pesticide Disposal statement to read:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
