Duratrol Household Flea Spray is a unique microencapsulated formulation for the residual control of fleas and ticks. The microcapsules provide a "timed release" mechanism for the active ingredient, chlorpyrifos, to provide up to 90-day control of adult fleas and flea larvae. Also kills many other household insects (see Directions for Use). For a total flea control program, ask your veterinarian about Duratrol Yard & Kennel Spray and Sectrol Two-Way Pet Spray and Foam.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING and frequently during use. Adjust sprayer to deliver a coarse spray.

Flea Treatment: Thoroughly vacuum all carpeting, upholstered furniture, along baseboards, under furniture and in closets. Seal vacuum bag and dispose. Mop hard floors. Replace pet bedding. Using a smooth back-and-forth motion, spray all floors and other aforementioned areas thoroughly, especially pet resting areas and other areas your pet frequents. Provide a good, even treatment, but do not soak the areas you treat. You should begin to see a noticeable flea reduction within 24 hours. If fleas reappear about 1 - 2 weeks after treatment, it is because they've hatched from their pupal (cocoon) stage. (Flea control products are generally ineffective against pupae.) If you notice this problem, you should either repeat treatment or allow the product's time-release microcapsules another week to kill the newly-emerged fleas.

Application Rates: 30 oz./800 sq. ft. - light to moderate infestations
30 oz./400 sq. ft. - severe infestations

To ^{Treat} Kill Other Household Pests: Including ants, carpet beetles, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, millipedes, silverfish, sow bugs, spiders, ticks, and water bugs - Direct spray to areas where pests are found such as baseboards, storage areas, closets, around water pipes, doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves and other similar areas. Spray directly on pest where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals: Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating. Remove dogs, cats and birds from room before spraying, and cover fish bowls and aquariums. **DO NOT SPRAY DIRECTLY ON PETS OR HUMANS.** NOTE: Kittens and puppies less than 12 weeks old may be sensitive to Duratrol Insecticide. Statement of Practical Treatment-

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin:** remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water. **If in eyes:** flush eyes with plenty of water. Storage: Store in original container out of the reach of children. Do not freeze or store above 120° F.

Unused Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
