

3. Submit dermal sensitization and acute inhalation studies. While the intended particle size may be too large to be respirable, fine droplets or small particles may be formed which are respirable. Enclosed for your information is a copy of "Comments On Standard Evaluation Procedure Inhalation Toxicology Testing (SEP/ Inhalation)." A copy of the Precautionary Review Section review of the toxicology data you submitted is enclosed for your information.
4. Submit the following product chemistry data.
 - a. Storage Stability - The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage should be in warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity and stored in similar containers you will be using in the trade. Note: For the Storage Stability study you cannot reference the concentrate you are using to formulate the product.
 - b. Corrosion Characteristics - this information can be noted during the storage stability study.
5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
