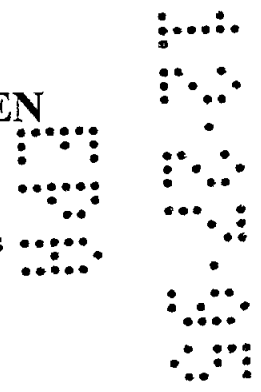

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- 1.) For best results, wash pet with an insecticidal shampoo (recommended by a veterinarian) prior to application of 3M PET FLEA FOAM. Rinse shampoo thoroughly from hair coat and towel dry to remove excess water.
- 2.) Avoiding the pet's eyes and nose, place dispensing nozzle directly on the pet's hair and depress the top of the dispensing valve to deliver the foam. Foam may also be dispensed into the hand and applied to the pet.
- 3.) Apply 3M PET FLEA FOAM to the pet's haircoat and massage haircoat until the foam disappears. Apply and massage-in enough foam to thoroughly moisten, but not soak, the entire haircoat including legs, feet and tail. The amount required will vary with the size of the pet and haircoat density. On cats, application of a one-second burst for each one-to-two pounds of body weight should provide effective coverage.
- 4.) Allow your pet to dry. Do not towel dry as this will remove many of the 3M PET FLEA FOAM microcapsules. A blow dryer works well to shorten the drying time.
- 5.) Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after application.
- 6.) Applied as directed, 3M PET FLEA FOAM (3M ANIMAL CARE EQUINE INSECT REPELLENT FOAM) provides flea kill for up to eight days. For best flea and tick control, reapply 3M PET FLEA FOAM (3M ANIMAL CARE EQUINE INSECT REPELLENT FOAM) weekly.

**FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF FROM BITING FLIES AND GNATS ON HORSES:**

- 1.) Apply 3M PET FLEA FOAM (3M ANIMAL CARE EQUINE INSECT REPELLENT FOAM) to areas of fly irritation. Moisten the skin but do not soak to dripping.
