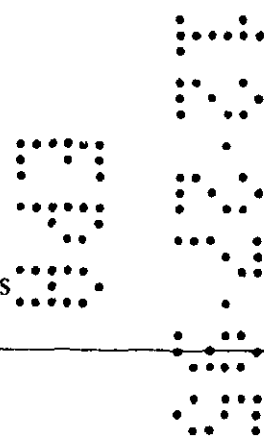

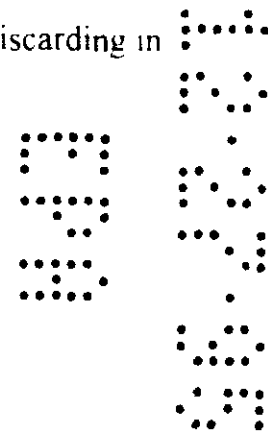
ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Cover or remove all nearby fish bowls and aquariums while spraying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Unused Pesticide Storage: Do not store above 110° F. Avoid freezing to prevent container damage. Do not store below 32°F. If exposed to temperatures below 32°F, warm to room temperature and shake well prior to use.

Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

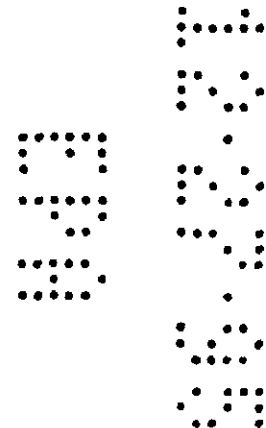
DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Before use, shake thoroughly and adjust sprayer to deliver a coarse spray.

1. For best results, wash pet with an insecticidal shampoo (recommended by a veterinarian) prior to application of 3M PET FLEA SPRAY. Rinse shampoo thoroughly from hair coat and towel dry to remove excess water.
2. Hold spray nozzle 4-6 inches from the pet. Apply 3M PET FLEA SPRAY to the hair and skin by brushing back the haircoat while spraying. Moisten the skin but do not soak to dripping.
3. Avoiding the pet's eyes and nose, spray the pet evenly over all areas of the body.
4. Allow the pet to air dry. Do not towel dry as this can remove many 3M PET FLEA SPRAY microcapsules. A blow dryer may be used.
5. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after application.
6. Applied as directed, 3M PET FLEA SPRAY (3M ANIMAL CARE EQUINE INSECT REPELLENT SPRAY) will provide flea kill for up to eight days. For best flea and tick control, reapply weekly.

1. Hold spray nozzle 4-6 inches from the horse. Apply 3M PET FLEA SPRAY (3M ANIMAL CARE EQUINE INSECT REPELLENT SPRAY) to areas of fly irritation. Moisten the skin but do not soak to dripping.
2. Do not spray directly into horse's eyes or nose.
3. Repeat treatment as necessary.
