Subject: Sectrol Pet and Premise Flea Spray
 EPA Reg. No. 10350-28
 Application for label amendment dated June 26, 1995

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Revise the precautionary statements to read as follows:
 Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals: Avoid contact with eyes. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some people or animals.

Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:
 If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.
 If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

You may want to consider changing the heading "Statement of Practical Treatment" to "First Aid".

Add the following sentence immediately after the heading "Storage and Disposal":
 Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Revise the Pesticide Disposal Statement to read as follows:
Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of
on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Revise the Container Disposal statement to read as follows:
Securely wrap original container in several layers of
newspaper and discard in trash.

You may not disclaim use in accordance with label
directions. Revise the second sentence of the second
paragraph of the warranty statement to read as follows:
3M shall not be liable for any damages, including indirect,
special, incidental and/or consequential damages, regardless
of the legal theory asserted, including negligence and/or
strict liability arising out of the use of or the inability
to use or the performance of the product, if product is not
used in accordance with label directions.

Move item 5) of the Directions for use, "Wash hands
thoroughly with soap and water after application." to the
Precautionary Statements.

Align by the decimal the percentages in the active
ingredient statement.

SECTROL PET & PREMISE FLEA SPRAY may be applied as a GENERAL SURFACE SPRAY.

Before use, shake thoroughly and adjust sprayer to deliver a coarse spray.

ON HOUSEHOLD SURFACES - Effective for up to 30 days

1. Thoroughly vacuum all carpeting, upholstered furniture, along baseboards, under furniture and in closets. Seal vacuum bag and dispose. Mop hard floors. Clean or replace pet bedding.
2. Using a smooth back-and-forth motion, thoroughly spray all areas and surfaces mentioned in step 1, especially pet resting areas and other areas that the pet frequents. Repeat application after 30 days or as needed.

[Fifteen (15)] [Thirty (30)] fluid ounces treats approximately [115] [230] square feet. SECTROL PET & PREMISE FLEA SPRAY should not damage surfaces that are unaffected by water.

ON DOGS AND CATS - Effective for up to 8 days

1. For best results, wash pet with an (insecticidal shampoo)(recommended by a veterinarian) (appropriate pesticidal shampoo) prior to application of SECTROL PET & PREMISE FLEA SPRAY . Rinse shampoo thoroughly from haircoat and towel dry to remove excess water.
2. Hold spray nozzle 4-6 inches from the pet. Apply SECTROL PET & PREMISE FLEA SPRAY to the hair and skin by brushing back the haircoat while spraying. Moisten the skin but do not soak to dripping.
3. Avoiding the pet's eyes and nose, spray the pet evenly, over all areas of the body.
4. Allow the pet to air dry. Do not towel dry as this can remove many SECTROL PET & PREMISE FLEA SPRAY microcapsules. A blow dryer may be used.
5. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after application.
6. Applied as directed, SECTROL PET & PREMISE FLEA SPRAY will provide flea kill for up to eight days. For best flea and tick control, reapply weekly.

TO TREAT OTHER HOUSEHOLD PESTS (including ants, beetles, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, firebrats, flies, gnats, moths, silverfish, spiders, waterbugs, and weevils): Direct this spray to areas where these pests are found. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.
