

Use from 0.0011 to 0.0066 gallons (0.14 to 0.82 fluid ounces) of UCARCIDE® 750 A 100 pounds of dry powder, to produce a concentration of from 100 to 600 ppm (parts grade glutaraldehyde (based on sturry solids) in the mixed slurry
