

STORAGE AND HANDLING

UCARCIDE™ 225 solutions are a corrosive to many forms of used materials of construction. It is available in galvanized iron, aluminum, and iron. These solutions can be stored and handled in bare metal, galvanized, polyethylene, stainless steel, or reinforced epoxy plastic equipment. This product freezes at about 32°C (88°F). Therefore, unless the storage tank is in a heated or underground location and insulation may be required. Breathing is needed, exposure to high temperatures should be avoided. For long storage, use up in small quantities. Material should be stored in a cool, dry place. For more information, contact your local office.

Use a stainless steel centrifugal pump is suggested for water service. Asbestos is suitable for gaskets and packing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. For proper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label directions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**Container Disposal.** Metal or Plastic Containers: These must be emptied thoroughly. Then offer for recycling or the reworking, or purchase and disposal of in a sanitary landfill or other processes approved by state and federal authorities. Plastic Containers may be incinerated, if allowed by state and local authorities. If burned, keep out of smoke.
