

STORAGE AND HANDLING

UCARCIDE® 115 solutions are corrosive to many commonly used materials of construction such as steel, galvanized iron, aluminum, tin, and zinc. These solutions can be stored and handled in baked phenolic-lined steel, polyethylene, stainless steel, or reinforced epoxy-plastic equipment. This product freezes at about -6°C (21°)F. Therefore, unless the storage tank is inside or underground, heating and insulation may be required. If heating is needed, exposure to high temperatures should be avoided. For short storage times (up to about 1 month, temperatures of up to 100°F can be tolerated but the preferred maximum storage temperature is about 80°F.

A stainless steel centrifugal pump is suggested for transfer service. Spiral wound stainless steel with teflon is suitable for gaskets and packing.

WATER FLOODS

UCARCIDE® 115 Antimicrobial should be added to a water flood system at a point of uniform mixing such as the area of addition of make up water to the holding tank.

Initial Treatment: When the system is noticeably contaminated, add 335-670 ppm UCARCIDE® 115 Antimicrobial to the system (0.33-0.66 gallons UCARCIDE® 115 per 1000 gallons flood water). Repeat until control is achieved.
