

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes serious eye damage, skin or mucous membrane irritation. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Handle in a well-ventilated area. Wash hands in eyes or on clothes after use. Do not use when not in use.

Inhalation of dust and/or vapors from wood treatment plant may cause prolonged irritation of well-maintained high voltage electrical equipment. MSHA/NIOSH approved respirator must be worn at level of inorganic arsenic exposure levels 10 micrograms/gm averaged over 8 hours. In industrial programs, personal protective equipment and protection must be determined by the employer. Instructions on the label must be followed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near food or drink or disposal areas.

STORAGE

Store in original containers which do not allow for leakage or contamination.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

If you have 100 pounds or less of excess pesticide, you may pour it down a drain. If this is not feasible, contact your state or local hazardous waste management agency for guidance.

GENERAL DISPOSAL

Do not pour into ground, surface water, or storm drains.

GTS

Do not use GTS unless you have a minimum of 100 pounds of excess product.

Always dilute excess up to 10% solution.

After dilution add 1 pound elemental per 50 gallons of water.

Do not extend time of application to water treated soil, sand or other soil treatments. Do not apply to flooded areas.
