TYPE A INSTRUCTIONS

To 1000 gallons of ACQ-C Solution, add 168 gallons of ACQ-Q* with agitation. This formula will yield 1168 gallons of ACQ Type A containing 8.9% CuO and 8.9% Didecyl dimethyl ammonium chloride on a weight/weight basis.

TYPE B INSTRUCTIONS

To 1000 gallons of ACQ-C Solution, add 84 gallons of ACQ-Q* with agitation. This formula will yield 1084 gallons of ACQ Type B containing 9.4% CuO and 4.7% Didecyl dimethyl ammonium chloride on a weight/weight basis.

TYPE C INSTRUCTIONS

To 1000 gallons of ACQ-C Solution, add 56 gallons of ACQ-Q* with agitation. This formula will yield 1056 gallons of ACQ Type C containing 9.6% CuO and 3.2% Didecyl dimethyl ammonium chloride on a weight/weight basis.
