

KILLS AND PROTECTS AGAINST HOUSE, HORN, STABLE
AND TABANID FLIES, LICE, FLEAS, MOSQUITOES, ANTS
ROACHES, TICKS AND SPIDERS.

FOR USE ON LIVESTOCK, IN BARNs, STABLEs, MILK
ROOMs, ATTICs AND BASEMENTs.

RECOMMENDED USE: A 1-2 oz. spray per 1000 cu. ft. is recommended for the specific application.

TO KILL HOUSE, HORN, HORSE, STABLE TABANID FLIES
AND TICKS ON DAIRY CATTLE, CALVES, BEEF CATTLE
AND HOGS: Spray 1-2 oz. FRMACIDE directly on the animal
so that the entire body of the animal is covered. Avoid areas
around nose, eyes and mouth. Avoid getting the hair.

FOR CONTROLLING FLIES IN BARNs AND HOLDING AREA
AND MILKROOM: Direct spray upward and toward the center
of the holding area and into corners. For best results close
all openings and turn off ventilating systems for at least 10
minutes. Apply FRMACIDE at the rate of 1-2 oz. per 1000
cu. ft. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ANTS, ROACHES, SPIDERS, AND CERTAIN OTHER
CRAWLING INSECTS IN ATTIC AND BASEMENTs: Apply
directly into the infested areas and on the infested surfaces.
This drives insects out for contact with killing mist. Spray
heavily all cracks, crevices and any place where these insects
crawl or breed. Repeat weekly or as needed to maintain last-
ing control.

CAUTION:

KEEP FROM REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed.
FRMACIDE may be used around food products if they are
covered to protect against direct contact when spraying. Use
as a space spray in Food Processing Plants only when plant
is not in operation. Clean surfaces before using. Cover fish
bowls, and remove birds for one hour in spraying rooms. Do
not spray directly on plants, and shrubbery. Avoid freezing.
Do not spray heavily on plastics, or asphalt tile. "DO NOT
USE, POUR, SPILL, OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN
FLAME."
