PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry place.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities.

COCKROACHES (WATERBUGS): Dust thoroughly all areas where roaches crawl and hide, such as around water pipes, in cracks and crevices, under and behind cabinets, refrigerators, and sinks.

ANTS AND SILVERFISH: Dust thoroughly areas around water pipes, in cracks, under and behind cabinets, refrigerators, and sinks, and around doors, windows and bookcases.

CARPET BEETLES: Dust along baseboards, under carpeting, rugs, furniture, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

SPIDERS AND SCORPIONS: Dust around windows, doors, and along baseboards. Make spot applications to surfaces over which these pests crawl, particularly in crawl spaces under houses or buildings.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION WITHIN FOOD AREAS AND NON-FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: For control of *Cockroaches (Waterbugs)*, *Ants*, *Spiders*, *Scorpions*, *Silverfish*, *Pantry Pests - exposed stages (Sawtooth, Grain Beetle, Rice Weevil, Cigarette Beetle, Drugstore Beetle, Indian Meal Moth)*.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREAS APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY: Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) would also be considered a food area.
