OUTDOOR INSECT CONTROL AROUND HOMES
AND BUILDING FOUNDATIONS

EXPAND THE FOLLOWING APPROVED COPY TO READ:

This treatment will aid in the reduction of, reduce annoyance from, and help to prevent entry into homes from commonly found insects which may feed upon the bait such as Millipedes, Earwigs, Pillbugs (Sowbugs), Cutworms, Mole Crickets, Field Crickets, and roaches, including Asian Cockroaches.

To control Mole Crickets, and Asian and other roaches on lawns, golf courses and ornamental turf (other than pastureland), apply at a rate of 3-1/2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (150 lbs/acre). Scatter evenly over the area to be treated using a mechanical spreader or other suitable device. Make application in the late afternoon. For best control, repeat application in one week.
