**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**If On Skin:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If In Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water for 5 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If Swallowed:** Drink plenty of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

**Note to Physician:** Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Antidote only by the physician's advice.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on flowering plants. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

This dust is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of eyes and of water. Do not pollute ground water by leaking or spillage. Flush spill with water.

**USE DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

D-Plus Dust Insecticide is a ready-to-use insecticide dust which controls pests as indicated below. Apply directly to cracks and crevices or other localized areas with a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment. The amount of D-Plus Dust to be applied will vary, but should usually be in the range of 1/3 to 2/3 ounces per square yard.

**Application Within Food Handling Establishments (Places Other Than Private Residences In Which Food Is Held, Processed, Prepared or Served) Including, But Not Limited To, Restaurants, Grocery Stores, Bakeries, Bottling Plants, Canneries and Grain Mills.** Use as a spot treatment in and around both food and non food areas to control cockroaches (including strains resistant to certain other insecticides), ants, crickets, firebrats, silverfish spiders and stored product insects such as confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, Indian meal moths, rice weevils, Mediterranean flour moths and red flour beetles. Apply as a light but uniform dust to localized areas. Do not allow the dust to contact food or food-contacting surfaces. Areas treated may include dark corners of rooms and closets, along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind stoves, refrigeration units and similar food preparation areas and equipment, floor drains and around plumbing and other utility installations. For ants apply to ant trails and wherever these pests may find entrance. Repeat treatment as needed but not more often than once every 7 days in restaurants and similar food service establishments or more often than once every 14 days in other types of food handling establishments, in case of emergency (call back). D-Plus Dust may be applied after 2 days from the last treatment, but emergency use should be limited to once per month.

**Application Within Residential Buildings Including Homes and Apartment Buildings and Within Non-food Areas of Industrial, Institutional, and Commercial Buildings Including Hospitals, Stores, Manufacturing Plants and Warehouses.** For Spot Treatment Only. Apply as a light but uniform dust to localized areas where cockroaches (including strains resistant to certain other insecticides), ants, clover mites, crickets, firebrats, silverfish and spiders are found or normally found, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, around plumbing and other utility installations. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

For control of carpenter bees, apply dust as a spot treatment along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on the ceiling, and wherever else these insects are seen or suspected.

For control of ticks and fleas, apply dust as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and skirting areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** To control the source of flea infestation, pets inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with a product registered for application to animals.

**Carpenter Ants:** Apply dust around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl or hide. Also force dust into cracks and crevices or through openings or small newly drilled holes into wall voids where ants and/or nests are present. Use a sufficient amount to lightly cover area surfaces.

**Wasps, Bees and Hornets:** Apply on nest and surrounding area. To treat nests in wall voids, drill a hole in the wall, blow in dust and reseal. Do not use this product to treat overhead nests.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
